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A blend of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Pinot Gris. The palate has a lovely fullness of fruit flavours coming from the three varieties of Pinot and finishes with drying tannins and excellent balance

Luscious strawberries and cream palate

Chalmers Heathcote 2016 Sagrantino, Aglianico 61

Fruit is from the highest point of the Estate. A small amount of barrel age gives structure, depth

Heritage Barossa Valley 2017 Semillon 37

Floral, fresh and peachy

Norfolk Rise Limestone Coast 2017 Pinot Grigio 45

Fruit driven with white stone fruit dominating, backed by a little winter spice this is true to style

Temple Bruer Langhorne Creek Autumn Harvest 2011 Riesling 45

A fruit forward style but still with cleansing acidity fruit purity

Protero Adelaide Hills 2016 Chardonnay 46

This is the brainchild of Frank and Rosemary Baldasso, using the skill and craftsmanship of Paul Drogemuller (Paracombe) and Steve Pannell (S.C. Pannell)

Spinifex Barossa Valley 2014 Lola 'Field Blend' 49

Lola is a unique blend from historical Barossa varieties including, Semillon, Ugni Blanc, Viognier, Clairette

La Petite Mort Granite Belt 2016 'Amphora White' Viognier, Marsanne, Roussanne	63
<i>The Rhone Valleys three white grapes co-fermented in terracotta with skin contact for 23 days, and yes it's from Queensland! Feeling adventurous?</i>

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Cullen Margret River 2014 'Amber' 94

Inspired by Pheasant's Tears this late picked, Semillon 64%, Sauvignon Blanc 36% of which 79% was fermented in new oak for four months with skins and pips included. Very vibrant and characterful

Mitchell Watervale 2006 Riesling 90

From the organic and dry-farmed Alcatraz vineyard, showing preserved lime. Long and waxy

Tibrook Estate, Adelaide Hills, 2003 Chardonnay 110

The second vintage by James, complex, rich and round and full of power

Poggio Anima 2013 Sicily Grillo 84

Made by the rockstar winemaker, Riccardo Campinoti, crunchy, textured and food friendly

Peggy Buronfosse Jura 2012 Savagnin, Chardonnay 119

Boundary pushing blend of local Savagnin with Chardonnay from Jura new comers

Hither &Yon, Bool Lagoon, 2017 Nero D'Avola 39

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Sun& Fun spicy and vibrant fruit, light oak, jubey dark forest fruits

Mezzo, Bool Lagoon, 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon 46

Made from pre-phylloxera Bordeaux cuttings and grown on Terra Rossa soils. This is value from the South East

Elegant expression of McLaren Vale Shiraz – bright fruits, black berry & violets 49

Eccolo Adelaide Hills 2015 Sangiovese 48

Emulating the great wines Chianti, grown at altitude – 400m, in Balhannah on the Bottin vineyard

Paracombe Adelaide Hills 2012 Shiraz Viognier 50

This wine will capture your senses with its fragrant aromatics and silky flavour. 97% Shiraz and 3% Viognier

NOON South Australia 2016 Twelve Bells 'Blend' 54

NOON's house wine, a blend of all five vineyards and made to enjoy on release

Heritage Barossa Valley 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon 59

James Hallidays "Quite achiever" of the Barossa. Cabernet fruit grown by neighbours Peter and Anita Frazer. Low yields deliver an intense, full throttle Cab Sauv

La Línea Adelaide Hills 2016 Mencia 60

Exuberant Spanish variety placing it amongst the first couple of very good examples popping their heads up from South Australia

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Twelftree Barossa Valley 2012 'Airport' Grenache 68

Michael Twelftrees sublime single site Greenock Grenache, juicy and round

Lethbridge, Geelong, 2017 'Menage a Noir' Pinot Noir 66

Dr. Nadeson's 'Village' style wine from the estate

Paracombe Adelaide Hills 2009 'Somerville' Shiraz 165

A special 'late harvest shiraz'. Named after the James Somerville who was the first to plant vines in the area in 1903

Louis Jabot 2015 Beaujolais Villages Gamay 'Combe aux Jaques' 99

Firm, grippy, and dark from this exceptional warm vintage

Allegrini La Grola 2005 Veronese 149

From the birthplace of Corvina this mature red is screaming drink me

Viette Nebbiolo 2005 Piedmont 200

Enjoy with game, from a warm harvest, deep, rich, and still with firm tannins

54% Cabernet – 46% Shiraz, aged in magnum this has just entered its drinking window

Low alcohol, Italian inspired. A slight spritz and very floral

Mitchell Clare Valley 2014 Noble Semillon (375ml) 9.5 32

Honey and marmalade reign supreme here with a lush lingering finish

Chateau Roumieu Sauternes 2014 Semillon, Sauv Blanc, Muscadelle (375ml) 22 75
